



FOREWORD

The Regimental Standing Orders (SOs) of the Princess of Wales' Own Regiment have been issued so that all components of the Regiment and all personnel of the Regimental Family, will have a ready reference to assist them in properly carrying out their responsibility and duties, in maintaining Regimental Customs and traditions, and in obeying those regulations which govern our Regimental life. These SOs are a consolidation of information, policies, and guidance of Regimental matters, and should be the ready reference for all member of the Regiment, in particular newly appointed NCOs and Officers.

These Standing Orders are published for the members of the Princess of Wales' Own Regiment, by the Regimental Headquarters, with the approval of the Regimental Senate, and under the authority of the Commanding Officer. Amendments to these Standing Orders can only be made on recommendation of the Regimental Senate and with the approval of the Commanding Officer. To ensure uniformity in all Regimental matters is achieved throughout the Regiment, all components and all individual members of the Regiment are expected to adhere to these Standing Orders.

This Standing Order supersedes any other manual on traditions that guides the Regiment.
