MEMBERSHIP POINTS:

- Membership in the PWOR Association is open to Serving and/or Retired CAF Members of the Regiment, CAF Members attach posted to the PWOR (Serving or Retired), Members of the Regimental Family which includes the Senate, Pipes & Drum Band, and Cadet Corps staff;
- Membership in the Association entitles the Member to be personally invited (usually by e-mail) to Association funded events and annual Regimental events that include the Regimental family;
- Membership entitles members to attend and have voting privileges at the Annual General Meeting usually held in early May;
- Memberships expire on the 31 December of each calendar year of valid year date, and an e-mail notice will be sent as a reminder in December annually;
- Renewal dues are to be paid within three months of expiration year (i.e. memberships that expire 31 Dec 2020 would need to be renewed by 31 March 2021 to remain in good standing);
- Memberships that have not been renewed for two consecutive years will require a “New Member” application and re-approval; and
- Memberships not renewed for three consecutive years will no longer be tracked and sent renewal notices.
